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SMALL COMMERCIAL SERVICE (1,11)

I. AVAILABILITY

Service under this rate schedule is available to commercial Members for all uses, including lighting, appliances, cooking, heating, refrigeration and motors all subject to the Standard Terms and Conditions for Electric Service of the Cooperative. Service under this rate schedule is limited to loads requiring 50 kW or less.

Members whose homes are on the same premises as their commercial establishments may include service to both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this rate schedule using the rate set forth below. If the Member provides for two meters, the Member's residential usage will be billed under the Residential Service Rate schedule and the Member's commercial usage under this rate schedule.

II. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single and three phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages. Individual motors having a rated capacity in excess of 10 h.p. shall be three-phase, unless otherwise approved by the Cooperative.

III. PROTECTION

Protection of three-phase motors against single-phasing shall be the responsibility of the Member. The Member is responsible for adequate overcurrent protection for all motors.

IV. MONTHLY RATE

Service Charge:

Single-phase Service	\$12.00
Three-phase Service	\$20.00

Energy Charge:

All kWh	\$0.05317 per kWh
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V. MINIMUM CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the monthly service charge specified above.

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VI. POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The above energy charges shall be increased as determined under the Power Cost Adjustment Clause PCA-BE.

VII. TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rate being 5% higher on the bill. In the event that the current monthly bill is not paid within twenty (20) days from the date of the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

VIII. CONTINUITY OF SERVICE

While the Cooperative makes every effort to maintain service, it does not guarantee a continuous, uninterrupted flow of electric service.

IX. QUALITY OF SERVICE

The Cooperative ascribes to provide the highest quality of electric service; however, conditions beyond its control (weather, accidental line damage, etc.) at times create voltage fluctuations and other service abnormalities. The Member is responsible for protection of the Member's equipment from damages caused by such conditions.

X. TEMPORARY SERVICE

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the Standard Terms and Conditions for Electric Service of the Cooperative.

XI. ENVIRONMENTAL COST ADJUSTMENT

The above energy charges shall be increased as determined under the Environmental Cost Adjustment Clause ECA-BE.
